Introduction

- DMU has undertaken research into the impact of Brexit and the changes to the immigration system on labour supply chains
- Research was concentrated on sectors known to use larger amounts of EU migrant labour
- 43 Businesses were interviewed both Labour Users and Labour Providers, in the Fresh Produce and Construction sectors
- The research found that :
 - Schemes like SAWS are insufficient to address the problems
 - Government is still to issue suitable clear guidelines
 - A lack of knowledge about post Brexit immigration routes
 - The need for advice and guidance on the new immigration system to assist businesses
